Our examination results continue to improve.

79% of students gained 5 or more A* – C grades

99.5% of students gained 5 or more A* – G grades

Of the students in Year 11 age group

- 2 students gained 15 GCSE grades A*–C
- 3 students gained 14 GCSE grades A*–C
- 18 students gained 13 GCSE grades A*–C
- 17 students gained 12 GCSE grades A*–C
- 28 students gained 11 GCSE grades A*–C
- 21 students gained 10 GCSE grades A*–C
- 150 students gained 5+ GCSE grades A*–C

The Average Point Score per student is 482

Our Early Entry Policy

As part of our Early Entry Policy, 148 Year 9 and 10 students sat 204 GCSE examinations and gained 190 A*–C grades.

79 Year 10 students sat 128 GCSE examinations and gained 119 A*–C grades in Mathematics, Community Languages and Religious Education of which 40 were at grades A and A*.

69 Year 9 students sat 76 GCSE examinations and gained 71 A*–C grades in Mathematics and Community Languages of which 30 were at A or A* grades.
